COMMISSION STAFF'S REVISED MAP AND CERTIFICATE

On March 25, 2021, NPH Market Street, LLC (NPH) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Gulf Coast Authority's (Gulf Coast) sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 20465 in Chambers County. The petition was filed under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h).

On June 17, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 4, requiring the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) to file any updated or revised documents needed to reflect the name change to Gulf Coast Authority, such as an updated map and certificate, on or before June 25, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. STAFF'S REVISED MAP, CERTIFICATE, AND CLARIFICATION

Staff hereby provides as attachments to this pleading an updated map reflecting the name change to Gulf Coast Authority. In addition, Staff hereby provides as an attachment to this pleading an updated certificate reflecting the same. Staff clarifies that the name change was reflected in an act of the Texas Legislature, and therefore, changing the name on the certificate from Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority to Gulf Coast Authority is a regulatory formality.¹ Staff further requests that the procedural schedule adopted in Order No. 2 remain in place for further processing of this docket.


