# ORDER NO. 2 FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses sufficiency of the petition and notice filed by NPH Market Street, LLC on March 25, 2021. NPH seeks the expedited release of a total of 134.0904 acres from their four parcels of land that lie within Gulf Coast Authority's sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 20465 in Chambers County.

## I. Finding Application Administratively Complete

On April 26, 2021, Commission Staff recommended that the petition be found administratively complete. The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively complete.

#### II. Notice

NPH stated in its petition that it mailed a copy of the petition to the CCN holder, Gulf Coast, via certified mail, return receipt requested, on the day the petition was filed with the Commission. The ALJ finds the notice sufficient.

#### III. Establishing Procedural Schedule

Under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541, the granting of streamlined expedited release initiates an appraisal process to determine the amount of monetary compensation that may be owed by the landowner to the certificate holder for the tract of land that was released. Therefore, an order granting approval for streamlined expedited release is interim in nature and, in the event the requested release is approved, the docket will continue for the purpose of determining the issue of compensation.
