ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND
OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the March 30, 2021 petition of Aqua Texas, Inc. and Parker County Special Utility District for approval of a service-area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend their water certificates of convenience and necessity in Parker County related to Aqua Texas' Saddle Club Estates Public Water System.

On April 29, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).


Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By May 29, 2021, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Pai Liu's April 29, 2021 memorandum attached to Commission Staff's sufficiency recommendation. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

By June 28, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
