AQUA'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 2

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:

COMES NOW, Aqua Texas, Inc. (Aqua) and files this Response to Order No. 2. In support thereof, Aqua would show the following.

On March 30, 2021, Aqua and Parker County Special Utility District filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) a petition for approval of a service-area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend their water certificates of convenience and necessity in Parker County related to Aqua's Saddle Club Estates Public Water System (Application). On May 3, 2021, Order No. 2 was issued which ordered Aqua to submit supplemental application information by May 29, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

Order No. 2 instructed Aqua to "supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described [in] Pai Liu's April 29, 201 memorandum" and to "not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete." However, Pai Liu's memorandum only includes instructions for remedying the deficiencies in the Application by providing customers with a copy of the notice. Attached as **Exhibit A** is the notice Aqua will send to customers based on the proposed notice included in Pai Liu's memorandum. Aqua respectfully requests that it be ordered

to send the notice attached as **Exhibit A** to its affected customers in the requested area despite the instruction provided in Order No. 2 tied to administrative completeness.

Aqua Texas, Inc. (Aqua) and Parker County Special Utility District (PCSUD) have filed a petition with the Public Utility Commission of Texas for approval of a service agreement pursuant to TWC §13.248 and to amend Aqua's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 13201 and PCSUD's CCN No. 12313 for the provision of retail water in Parker County, Texas.

The requested area includes 11 current customers, is located approximately 5 mile(s) west of downtown Weatherford, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Chappel Hill Court and the terminus of Brook Hollow Lane; on the east by Patrick Creek; on the south by Greenwood Road; and on the west by Green Gables Lane.

The requested area includes approximately <u>47</u> acres, comprised of <u>47</u> acres of transferred area (from CCN No. 12313).

The result of the petition will be the addition of approximately <u>47</u> acres to CCN No. 13201.

The result of the petition will be the subtraction of approximately 47 acres from CCN No. 12313.

- (5) your proposed adjustment to the application which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-3326, or call the Public Utility Commission at (512) 936-7120 or (888) 782-8477. Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.

A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written request will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.
