NOTICE OF PETITION OF AQUA TEXAS, INC. AND PARKER COUNTY SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT FOR APPROVAL OF A SERVICE AGREEMENT AND TO PROVIDE WATER UTILITY SERVICE IN PARKER COUNTY, TEXAS.

To: All Affected Customers at their Current Billing Address

Aqua Texas, Inc. (Aqua) and Parker County Special Utility District (PCSUD) have filed a petition with the Public Utility Commission of Texas for approval of a service agreement pursuant to TWC §13.248 and to amend Aqua's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 13201 and PCSUD's CCN No. 12313 for the provision of retail water in Parker County, Texas.

The requested area includes <u>11</u> current customers, is located approximately <u>5</u> mile(s) <u>west</u> of downtown <u>Weatherford</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Chappel Hill Court and the terminus of Brook Hollow Lane</u>; on the east by <u>Patrick Creek</u>; on the south by <u>Greenwood</u> <u>Road</u>; and on the west by <u>Green Gables Lane</u>.

The requested area includes approximately <u>47</u> acres, comprised of <u>47</u> acres of transferred area from CCN No. 12313.

The result of the petition will be the addition of approximately <u>47</u> acres to CCN No. 13201.

The result of the petition will be the subtraction of approximately <u>47</u> acres from CCN No. 12313.

The minimum monthly charges have been in effect since January 1, 2013.

The gallonage charges have been in effect since January 1, 2015.


You may request a public hearing. A request for a public hearing must be in writing and include:


- (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number;
- (2) the Utility name, docket number or another recognizable reference to this application;
- (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing";
- (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and
- (5) your proposed adjustment to the application which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-3326, or call the Public Utility Commission at (512) 936-7120 or (888) 782-8477. Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.

A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written request will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.
