**COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On April 1, 2021, Rodney Earl Mohnke, Stephen Lee Mohnke, Melvin Max Mohnke, Kenneth Wayne Mohnke, Kathleen Ann Mohnke-Blakely, and Mel Mohnke, Trustees of the Mohnke Living Trust dated December 7, 1996 (collectively, Mohnke Trustees) filed a petition to amend H-M-W Special Utility District's (H-M-W SUD) water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Harris County by streamlined expedited release. The Mohnke Trustees seek the expedited release of a total of 99.2669 acres of land that lie within H-M-W SUD's CCN number 10342.

On June 4, 2021, H-M-W SUD filed a motion to intervene, which was granted by the ALJ in Order No 3 filed on June 25, 2021. Order No. 3 also established a deadline of June 28, 2021, for the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) to file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the petition and notice and proposed procedural schedule.

**I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. On June 10, 2021, H-M-W SUD filed a motion regarding the administrative completeness of the petition, and on June 14, 2021, H-M-W SUD filed a response to the petition and supplemented its motion to extend. Staff requires additional time to consider the recent filings by H-M-W SUD and complete its supplemental recommendation. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that an extension be granted until July 12, 2021.

## **II. CONCLUSION**

Staff respectfully requests the issuance of an order granting Staff's request and extending the deadline for Staff to file its supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the petition and notice and proposed procedural schedule.
