**ORDER NO. 14
DECLINING TO RULE ON PENDING MOTIONS**

On November 2, 2021, the Commission entered, in this matter, an order granting streamlined expedited release and releasing the petitioners' tract of land in Harris County from H-M-W Special Utility District's certificated service area under certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 10342. On March 21, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) entered a Notice of Approval Making a Determination on Compensation (NOA). With the issuance of the NOA, this matter was closed.

Almost two-and-a-half months later, on June 3, 2022, Rodney Earl Mohnke, Stephen Lee Mohnke, Melvin Max Mohnke, Kenneth Wayne Mohnke, Kathleen Ann Mohnke-Blakely and Mel Mohnke, Trustee of the Mohnke Living Trust dated December 7, 1996 (collectively, petitioners) filed a renewed second motion to compel asking the ALJ to order H-M-W SUD to file the amended CCN in the real property records.

Additionally, on June 7, 2022, B&D Environmental, Inc. filed a notice of noncompliance stating that neither the petitioners, nor H-M-W SUD, have paid their half of the cost for preparing Commission Staff's appraisal. B&D Environmental asks that the parties be found in non-compliance of the requirements of the NOA and asks the ALJ to order the petitioners and H-M-W SUD to comply with the NOA.

Because this docket is closed, the ALJ lacks jurisdiction to rule on the pending motions. The petitioners and B&D Environmental are free to file their complaints in new dockets.
