COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On April 5, 2021, Nerro Supply, LLC (Nerro) filed an application under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.25(b)(2) for approval of a pass-through rate change related to the water use fee imposed by North Harris County Regional Water Authority.

On April 6, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed a notice setting a deadline of May 5, 2021 for the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) to file a recommendation on the application and notice, and to propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. So that it may complete its review of Nerro's application, Staff requests that the deadline to file a recommendation on the application and notice, and to propose a procedural schedule, be extended to May 19, 2021.

II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons specified above, Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ grant an extension of time for Staff to file a recommendation on the application and notice, and to propose a procedural schedule as appropriate.
