## ORDER NO. 3 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICENT

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice of the April 1, 2021 application of Live Oak Hills and Flag Creek Ranch Water Systems and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and associated acreage in Llano and McCulloch counties. On April 5 and May 5 and 6, 2021, the applicants filed supplemental information.

On June 7, 2021, the applicants filed an affidavit attesting that notice was provided to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on June 4, 2021.

On June 16, 2021, Commission Staff recommended that notice be found sufficient.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient. The applicants meet the notice requirements under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 239(c).

The following procedural schedule applies for continued processing:

Therefore, 30 days after June 4, 2021 is July 4, 2021. Because July 4, 2021 falls on a Sunday and the Commission is closed for business on Monday, July 5, 2021, the deadline for intervention is Tuesday, July 6, 2021 under 16 TAC § 22.4(a).
