### **RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 2**

COME NOW T&W Water Service Company ("T&W") and Belle Oaks Water and Sewer Co., Inc. ("Belle Oaks") (collectively, "Applicants") and file this response to Order No. 2 Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient and Establishing an Opportunity to Cure.

On April 9, 2021, Applicants filed an Application for Sale, Transfer, or Merger of Retail Public Utilities in Jefferson County, Texas. The application seeks the sale of Belle Oaks' public water system (PWS ID 1230075) and wastewater system (TPDES Permit No. WQ0013565001) to T&W Water, and the transfer of Belle Oaks Certificates of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") Nos. 13067 and 20965 to T&W's CCN No. 12892 and issuance of a new sewer CCN for T&W. Order No. 2 issued on May 11, 2021 provided until June 9, 2021 for Applicants to supplement the application to cure the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Therefore this pleading is timely filed.

In Commission Staff's Recommendation on Administrative Completeness and Proposed Notice, Staff attached a memo which identified additional content needed for processing the Application. Applicants are supplementing the Application with the information identified below.

1. Provide a copy of the "Certificate for Account Status" for T&W Water.

Attached as **Exhibit A** please find a copy of T&W's Franchise Tax Account Status from the Office of the Comptroller.

2. Provide a copy of T&W organization chart.

T&W will produce its organization chart pursuant to the Protective Order issued in this docket.

3. Provide a copy of the latest Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) inspections done at Belle Oaks' water and sewer systems.

Attached as **Exhibit B** please find a copy of the TCEQ's latest inspection for the Belle Oaks water system. To date, a TCEQ inspection has not occurred for the Belle Oaks sewer system.

4. Provide proof that a transfer request for the wastewater permit has been submitted to the TCEQ.

Attached as **Exhibit C** is a copy of the Application to Transfer a Wastewater Permit or CAFO Permit filed by T&W with the TCEQ.

### PRAYER

Applicants respectfully request the Commission approve their application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Jefferson County. If for any reason the Commission finds the information submitted herein is still insufficient for application acceptance, Applicants respectfully request that they be notified immediately and provided an opportunity to cure any additional deficiencies identified.

On November 30, 2020, Ms. Vanessa Stansbury of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Beaumont Region 10 Office conducted an investigation of the above-referenced regulated entity to evaluate compliance with applicable requirements for public water supply. Enclosed is a summary which lists the investigation findings. During the investigation, concerns were noted which were alleged noncompliances that have been resolved as Areas of Concern based on subsequent corrective action. In addition, certain outstanding alleged violations were identified for which compliance documentation is required. Please submit to this office by April 26, 2021, a written description of corrective action taken and the required documentation demonstrating that compliance has been achieved for the outstanding alleged violation.

In the listing of the alleged violations, we have cited applicable requirements, including TCEQ rules. Please note that both the rules themselves and the agency brochure entitled *Obtaining TCEQ Rules* (GI 032) are located on our agency website at <a href="http://www.tceq.state.tx.us">http://www.tceq.state.tx.us</a> for your reference. If you would like a hard copy of this brochure mailed to you, you may call and request one from either the Beaumont Region 10 Office at (409) 898-3838 or the Central Office Publications Ordering Team at 512-239-0028.

The TCEQ appreciates your assistance in this matter. Please note that the Legislature has granted TCEQ enforcement powers which we may exercise to ensure compliance with environmental regulatory requirements. If you have additional information that we are unaware of, you have the opportunity to contest the violations documented in this notice. Should you choose to do so, you must notify the Beaumont Region 10 Office within 21 days from the date of this letter. At that time, Ronald Hebert, Water Section Manager, will schedule a violation review meeting to be conducted within 21 days from the date of this letter.

However, please be advised that if you decide to participate in the violation review process, the TCEQ may still require you to adhere to the compliance schedule included in the attached Summary of Investigation Findings until an official decision is made regarding the status of any or all of the contested violations.

Failure by Belle Oaks Water and Sewer Co Inc - Belle Oak Water to conduct all chloramine effectiveness sampling.

During the investigation, it was noted that the water system began operating as a public water supply system around March or April 2020; however, they did not begin the six month nitrate and nitrite baseline sampling at the entry point and the quarterly nitrate and nitrite sampling within the distribution system until November 2020. It was also noted that the water system did not collect the required entry point sampling for total chlorine, monochloramine, and free available ammonia from June 1, 2020 to June 29, 2020; August 24, 2020 to September 7, 2020; and September 21, 2020 to October 5, 2020. The water system also did not collect the required distribution sampling for monochloramine and free available ammonia from June 10, 2020 to June 30, 2020; August 24, 2020 to September 7, 2020; and September 21, 2020 to October 5, 2020. On December 16, 2020, the water system stated that the water system's chloramine effectiveness sampling did not get fully started until November 2020 due to the start-up of the water system and working with the source water's triggers at the beginning. The water system had also previously noted that the water system did not begin the required nitrate and nitrite sampling until November 2020 due to the water system needing to purchase the necessary equipment in order to conduct this type of sampling

Recommended Corrective Action: Ensure that the water system collects six months of baseline nitrate and nitrite samples from the entry point before beginning quarterly nitrate and nitrate sampling at the entry point. Ensure that the water system collects quarterly nitrate and nitrate samples from distribution system. Ensure that the water system collects monochloramine and free available ammonia residual from the entry point and distribution system on a weekly basis. Submit two months of weekly monochloramine and free available ammonia residual sample results for both the entry point and distribution system, two months of monthly nitrate and nitrite sample results for the entry point, and one set of quarterly nitrate and nitrite sample results for the distribution system to the Beaumont Regional Office.

Failure by Belle Oaks Water and Sewer Co Inc - Belle Oak Water to conduct Customer Service Inspections prior to providing continuous water service to new construction, on any existing service either when the water purveyor has reason to believe that cross-connections or other potential contaminant hazards exist, or after any material improvement, correction, or addition to the private water distribution facilities.

### **BELLE OAK WATER**

During the investigation, it was noted that the water system has not conducted Customer Service Inspections on any of their 36 connections prior to providing continuous water service to these new connections. On December 16, 2020, the water system informed the investigator that these inspections had not been conducted due to the water system working with the homeowners and builders to get the inspections scheduled. They also noted that the new service agreement for the water system requires Customer Service Inspections to be conducted.

**Recommended Corrective Action:** Ensure that all customer connections, including the water systems current 36 connections. Submit the completed Customer Service Inspection Forms for each of the current 36 connections to the Beaumont Regional Office.

### **Alleged Violation:**

Failure by Belle Oaks Water and Sewer Co Inc - Belle Oak Water to verify the accuracy of manual disinfectant residual analyzers at least once every 90 days.

During the investigation, it was noted that the water system did not verify the accuracy of their Hach DR900 for chlorine from March 25, 2020 to July 1, 2020 (98 days) and the accuracy of their Hach Pocket Colorimeter II for chlorine from March 26, 2020 to July 2, 2020 (98 days).

Recommended Corrective Action: Ensure that the water system verifies the accuracy of manual disinfectant residual analyzers at least once every 90 days.

**Resolution:** During the investigation, it was noted that the water system has verified the accuracy of the Hach DR900 and Hach Pocket Colorimeter II for chlorine at least once every 90 days since July 1 and July 2, 2020, respectively.

Failure by Belle Oaks Water and Sewer Co Inc - Belle Oak Water to verify the accuracy analyzers used to determine effectiveness of chloramination at least once every 90 days.

During the investigation, it was noted that the water system did not verify the accuracy of their Hach DR900 for monochloramine and free available ammonia from March 26, 2020 to July 1, 2020 (97 days).

Recommended Corrective Action: Ensure that the water system verifies the accuracy analyzers used to determine effectiveness of chloramination at least once every 90 days.

**Resolution:** During the investigation, it was noted that the water system has verified the accuracy of the Hach DR900 for monochloramine and free available ammonia at least once every 90 days since July 1, 2020.

Failure by Belle Oaks Water and Sewer Co Inc - Belle Oak Water to maintain a total chlorine residual of at least 0.5 mg/L throughout the distribution system.

During the investigation, low chlorine residuals were noted on March 30, 2020 (0.1 milligram per liter (mg/L) at 15539 Grace), on June 3, 2020 (0.2 mg/L at 15539 Grace), and June 30, 2020 (0.2 mg/L at 1350 Alice).

This violation is subject to 40 CFR Part 141 Subpart S-Groundwater Rule regarding significant deficiencies and is defined in 30 TAC Chapter 290. Significant deficiencies must be corrected or be part of a state approved corrective action plan documented in a Notice of Violation.

**Recommended Corrective Action:** Ensure that the water system maintains a total chlorine residual of at least 0.5 mg/L throughout the distribution system at all times.

**Resolution:** During the investigation, it was noted that the water system has maintained adequate total chlorine residuals since July 6, 2020.

### **ADDITIONAL ISSUES**

Description Item #1

### **Additional Comments**

During the investigation, it was noted that the lead and copper sample sites in the water system's monitoring plan were not listed. Please note that this water system started operating as a Public Water System around March or April 2020 and that the Texas Drinking Water Watch (DWW) website does not specify any of this sampling information. On December 16, 2020, the water system informed the investigator that the lead and copper sample sites are still in the process of being established and submitted a draft of the proposed sample sites. It is suggested that the water system ensure that the Monitoring Plan is completed accordingly once the locations of the lead and copper sample sites are finalized. This may result in future alleged violations.

Item #3

During the investigation, it was noted that the Notice to Homeowners and Plumbers Form included with the Customer Service Agreement did not state, "No pipe or pipe fittings which contain more than 0.25% lead exists on or after January 4, 2014." Instead, it stated the old language that noted, "No pipe or pipe fitting which contains more than 8.0% lead exists in private water distribution facilities installed on or after July 1, 1988." It also stated. "No solder or flux which contains more than 0.2% lead exists in private water distribution facilities installed on or after July 1, 1998," when the vear should be 1988. Please note that the Customer Service Agreement contained the most up-to-date requirements for pipes, pipe fittings, solder, and flux.

Item #4

It is suggested that the water system update their distribution map to include fire hydrant locations so that the water system can keep track of all potential flushing locations throughout the water system as the subdivision continues to grow.

Item #2

During the investigation, it was noted that the Customer Service Inspection (CSI) Form included with the Customer Service Agreement and Backflow Form attachment was not the required TCEQ-20699 Form. The included CSI Form appeared to have the same information as the TCEQ-20699 Form; however, this form was not in the same format as the TCEQ-20699 Form and had the water system's name at the top of the form. Please note that the water system will need to ensure that the TCEQ-20699 Form is used when conducting CSIs for the water system.

item #7

During the investigation, it was noted that there are multiple instances in the chloramine effectiveness sample records where the monochloramine residual and the total chlorine residual exceeded a difference of 15%. Please note that the monochloramine residual should ideally be within 15% of the total chlorine residual. It is suggested that the water system monitor the difference between the total chlorine and monochloramine residual results and discuss this issue with West Jefferson if the issue persists.

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Item #11

During the investigation, it was noted that Well No. 1 (G1230075A) was not in use and not plugged. According to 30 TAC 290 46(u), wells that are not in use and are non-deteriorated are required to be tested every five years or as required by the executive director to prove that they are in a non-deteriorated condition. Plugging the well is another option that the water system may choose. On January 21, 2021, the water system submitted an email dated February 20, 2020 from Mr. Christopher Frazier, TCEQ Drinking Water Inventory and Protection Team, who stated that the water system was activated. The water system will need to ensure that they test Well No. 1 within five years from February 20, 2020. This may result in future alleged violations.
