ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND NOTICE
SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the April 8, 2021 petition of the City of Austin and Forest Oaks Mobile Homes, LLC for approval of a service-area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend their water certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Travis County. On July 6, 2021 Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness, sufficiency of notice, and proposed procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete. Further, the ALJ finds that the petitioners have satisfied the notice requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.253(c) and that no further notice is required.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the petition	August 30, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	September 10, 2021
