**FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND**  
**ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by CPR Water Supply Company, LLC. On August 16, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the provided notice.

On August 2, 2021, CPR Water filed the affidavit of Bret W. Fenner, authorized representative for CPR Water, attesting that notice of the application was mailed to the affected parties on July 16, 2021. Included in the filing was the affidavit of Danielle Prekker, legal clerk of the *Tyler Morning Telegraph*, which is a newspaper of general circulation in Smith County, indicating that notice of the application was published on July 15 and 22, 2021.

The ALJ finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:
