ABATING PROCEEDING**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's January 7, 2022 motion to abate, or, in the alternative, motion to dismiss. Commission Staff stated it is still waiting for CPR Water Supply Company, LLC to file the final approval letter for the distribution system from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). Commission Staff requires the requested information for further processing of this docket. On December 13, 2021, CPR Water stated that plans and specifications for the distribution system are being submitted to the TCEQ for approval, and that they will provide updates as received regarding the TCEQ's approval process for the plans and specifications

The administrative law judge grants Commission Staff's motion to abate the proceeding. CPR Water is directed to file monthly updates beginning on February 1, 2022 and continuing until the TCEQ approval letter is received and filed with the Commission.
