Dear Mr. Fontaine:

On December 15, 2021, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received planning material with your letter dated December 13, 2021 for the proposed distribution system improvements. Based on our review of the information submitted, the project generally meets the minimum requirements of Title 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 290 – Rules and Regulations for Public Water Systems and is conditionally approved for construction if the project plans and specifications meet the following requirement(s):

1. The hydrostatic leakage rate for polyvinyl chloride (PVC) pipe and appurtenances shall not exceed the amount allowed or recommended by formulas in American Water Works Association (AWWA) Standard C605, as required by 30 TAC §290.44(a)(5). Please ensure that the formula for this calculation is correct and in use;

$$Q = \frac{LD\sqrt{P}}{148,000}$$

Where:

- Q = the quantity of makeup water, in gallons per hour;
- L = the length of the pipe section being tested, in feet;
- D = the nominal diameter of the pipe, in inches; and
- P = the average test pressure during the hydrostatic test, in pounds per square inch.
- 2. The use of pipes and pipe fittings that contain more than 0.25% lead or solders and flux that contains more than 0.2% lead is prohibited as required in 30 TAC Section 290.44(b)(1).

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The submittal consisted of 17 sheets of engineering drawings and technical specifications. The approved project consists of:

- 4,800 linear feet of 8-inch, American Water Works Association Standard C-900, dimension ratio 18 polyvinyl chloride pipe;
- Associated valves, fittings, and appurtenances.

This approval is for the construction of the above listed items only. Any wastewater components contained in this design were not considered. The authorization provided in this letter does not relieve a Public Water System from the need to comply with other applicable state and federal regulations.

The CPR Development public water supply system provides water treatment.

The project is located 500 feet south of intersection of State Highway 155 and Farm to Market 344 in Smith County, Texas.

An appointed engineer must notify the TCEQ's Region 5 Office in Tyler at (903) 535-5100 when construction will start. Please keep in mind that upon completion of the water works project, the engineer or owner will notify the commission's Water Supply Division, in writing, as to its completion and attest to the fact that the completed work is substantially in accordance with the plans and change orders on file with the commission as required in 30 TAC §290.39(h)(3).

Please refer to the Plan Review Team's Log No. P-12152021-112 in all correspondence for this project.

Please complete a copy of the most current Public Water System Plan Review Submittal form for any future submittals to TCEQ.
