



ORDER NO. 2 REQUIRING CLARIFICATION FROM THE PETITIONER

On April 9, 2021, D.P.S.F.L.P. Ltd. (the petitioner) filed a petition to amend Aqua Texas, Inc.'s water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Montgomery County by streamlined expedited release. On April 29, 2021, the petitioner filed what appears to be another petition. The two filings raise a number of questions that require clarification.

- The petition filed on April 9 includes seven maps identified as Exhibit 1 and seven maps identified as Exhibit 2.
 - Which of the seven maps marked as Exhibit 1 is actually the exhibit?
 - Which of the seven maps marked as Exhibit 2 is actually the exhibit?
 - O Do the seven maps differ from one another, or are they duplicates?
 - o If they are duplicates, why were seven copies filed?
 - o If they differ from one another, how so?
- The document filed on April 29 is not accompanied by any explanation.
 - o Is the April 29 filing merely a duplicate of what was filed on April 9? If so, why was it necessary? May it be disregarded?
 - o Is the April 29 filing intended to be an amended application? If so, how does it differ from what was filed on April 9?
 - O Do the maps filed on April 29 differ from those filed on April 9?
 - The April 29 document includes two maps identified as Exhibit 1.
 - Which of the two maps marked as Exhibit 1 is actually the exhibit?
 - Do the two maps differ from one another, or are they duplicates?

The petitioner must, by May 7, 2021, filing briefing answering the questions raised above. The schedule adopted in Order No. 1 remains in effect.
