PETITION OF DPSFLP LTD TO AMEND AQUA TEXAS, INC.'S **CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE** AND NECESSITY IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY BY EXPEDITED RELEASE

DO4 PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION

ORDER NO.3 FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, NOTICE INSUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses sufficiency of the petition filed by DPSFLP Ltd. filed on April 9, 2021. The applicant seeks the expedited release of land that lies within Aqua Texas, Inc.'s water certificate of convenience and necessity number 13203 in Montgomery County.

I. **Finding Application Administratively Complete**

On May 10, 2021, Commission Staff recommended that the petition be found administratively complete. The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively complete.

II. **Finding Notice Insufficient**

The ALJ finds the notice insufficient, for the reasons described in the memorandum of Patricia Garcia, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation. By May 20, 2021, DPSFLP must file proof that Aqua Texas was provided notice of the petition. By June 1, 2021,¹ Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on proof of notice.

III. **Establishing Procedural Schedule**

Under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541, the granting of streamlined expedited release initiates an appraisal process to determine the amount of monetary compensation that may be owed by the landowner to the certificate holder for the tract of land that was released. Therefore, an order granting approval for streamlined expedited release is interim in nature and, in the event the requested release is approved, the docket will continue for the purpose of determining the issue of compensation.
