**ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the April 9, 2021 application of Brazos Valley Septic & Water, Inc. and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Robertson County. The applicants filed supplemental information on May 4, 5, and 6, 2021.


The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before July 2, 2021, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the June 3, 2021 memorandum of Patricia Garcia. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before August 2, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
