COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRTEENTH STATUS UPDATE

On April 15, 2021, Inline Development Inc. (Inline) filed an application under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.25(b) for approval of a pass-through rate change related to an increase in fees imposed on the utility by North Harris County Regional Water Authority.

On July 22, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed a notice directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a status report on abatement beginning on September 1, 2021 and continuing monthly thereafter. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. STATUS UPDATE

Staff has conferred with Inline representatives and understands that Inline is working to finalize, and intends to file with the Commission, an application for a sale, transfer, or merger (STM) as soon as is practicable. Staff will continue to work with Inline to ensure that the STM application is filed as soon as possible. Consistent with the ALJ's Order filed on July 22, 2021, Staff will provide another status update on November 5, 2022.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully provides this status update on abatement and will file another status update on November 5, 2022.
