COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On April 15, 2021, Inline Development Inc. (Inline) filed an application under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.25(b) for approval of a pass-through rate change related to an increase in fees imposed on the utility by North Harris County Regional Water Authority.

On May 25, 2021, the administrative law judge filed a notice finding the application insufficient and directing the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) to file a supplemental recommendation on the application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule, if applicable, by June 14, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff is currently working with Inline to clarify certain information related to the sufficiency of the application. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending the deadline for Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on the application and notice until June 21, 2021.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending Staff's deadline to file a supplemental recommendation on the application and notice until June 21, 2021.
