
**ATTACHMENTS TO JOINT PROPOSED NOTICE OF APPROVAL

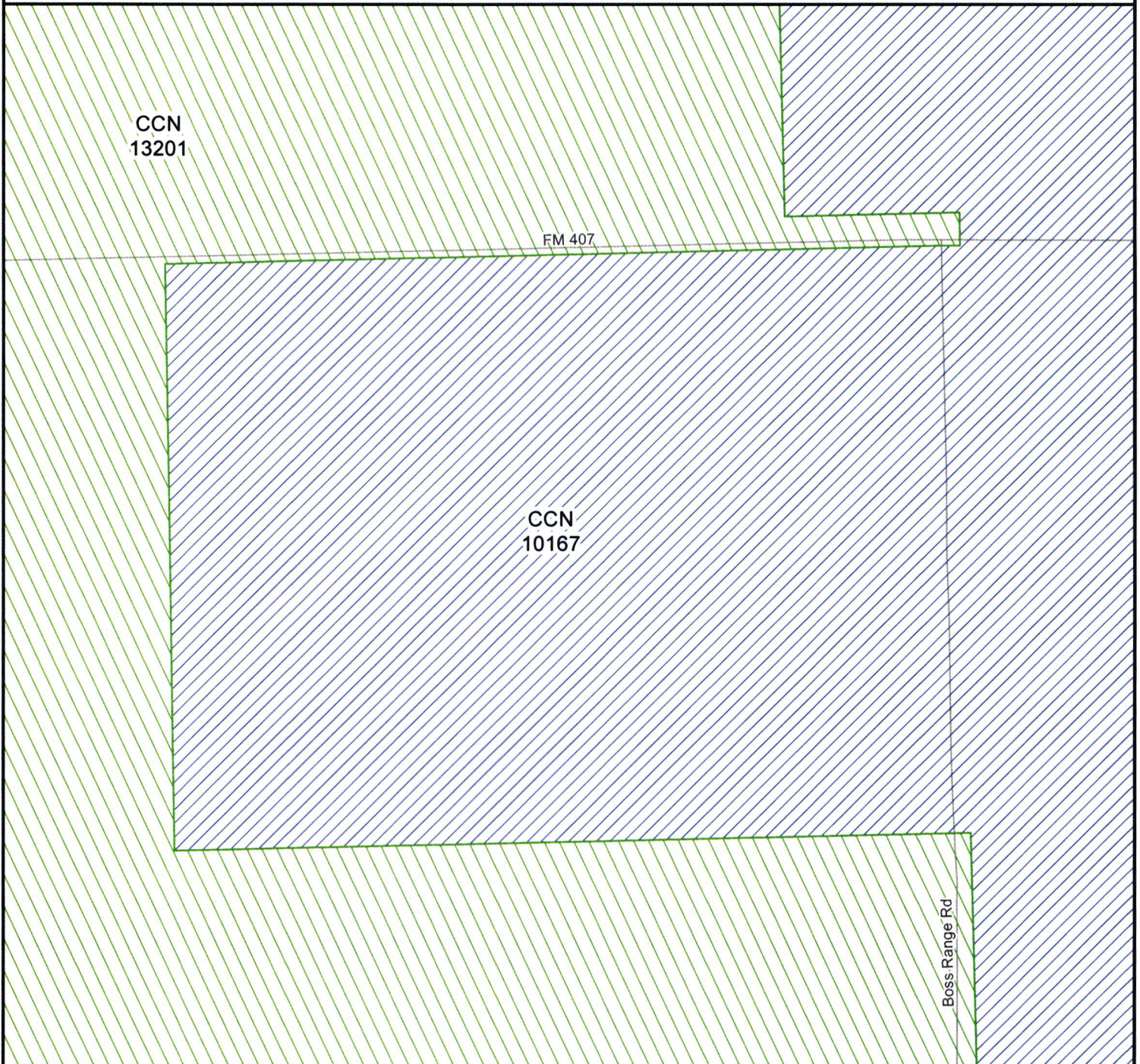
