COMMISSION STAFF'S REVISED RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On May 6, 2021, CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC (CSWR) and Alpha Utility of Camp County, LLC (Alpha Utility) (collectively, the Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale and transfer of facilities and certificate rights in Camp County. Specifically, the Applicants seek approval for CSWR, certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 13290, to acquire facilities and to transfer all of the water service area from Alpha Utility under water CCN No. 12696. The applicants filed supplemental information on June 23, 2021.

On June 7, 2021, the for the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) recommended that the application was administratively incomplete. On June 8, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 2 finding the application incomplete and deficient and establishing a deadline of August 6, 2021 for the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule for the further processing of this docket. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the application and supplemental information submitted by the Applicants and, as detailed in the attached memorandum from Jolie Mathis, Infrastructure Division, recommends that the application is administratively complete. Staff initially determined that the application did not include information responsive to Question 24, part B. However, Staff has re-reviewed confidential Attachment I-1filed on May 7, 2021 and has

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concluded that this information supports a recommendation that the application is sufficient for further processing. Staff's recommendation is not a comment on the merits of the application.

II. NOTICE

At this time, Staff recommends that the Applicants proceed with providing public notice to all current customers, neighboring utilities, political subdivisions, and other persons listed in the attached memorandum using the notice form provided by Ms. Mathis. Along with each individual notice, Staff recommends that the Applicants provide an accurate map delineating the requested service area. Once notice has been provided, Staff recommends that the Applicants file proof of notice as described in the attached memorandum, including an affidavit specifying the name and address of every person and entity to whom notice was provided, the date that the notice was provided, and a copy of the map provided with the notice. Finally, Staff recommends that the Applicants use the attached notice and affidavit to meet these requirements.

III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends that the application be found administratively complete. Therefore, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

On May 6, 2021, CSWR-Texas Utility Utility Company, LLC (CSWR) and Alpha Utility of Camp County, LLC (Alpha Utility) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger (STM) of facilities and certificate rights in Camp County, Texas, under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.301 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239.

Specifically, CSWR, certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 13290, seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all of the water service area from Alpha Utility under water CCN No. 12696.

The requested area includes 163 current customers and approximately 217 acres of area transferred from CCN No. 12696.

The application proposes the subtraction of approximately 217 acres from CCN No. 12696 and the addition of approximately 217 acres to CCN No. 13290.

Based on the mapping review by Tracy Montes, Infrastructure Division, the maps submitted on May 6, 2021 are sufficient. Based on the financial and managerial review by Fred Bednarski, Rate Regulation Division, and my technical and managerial review of the information filed by the Applicants, I recommend that the application be deemed administratively complete. I further recommend that the Applicants be ordered to do the following:

- 1) Provide notice of the application by first-class mail to the following:
 - a. Cities, districts, and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service whose corporate boundaries or certificated service area are located within two miles from the outer boundary of the requested area:

- Bi County WSC (CCN No. 10490)
- City of Mount Pleasant (CCN No. 10509)
- Tri SUD (CCN No. 10402)
- Titus County FWSD 1
- Town of Rocky Mound
- b. The county judge of each county that is wholly or partially included in the requested area:
 - Camp County Judge
- c. Each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partially included in the requested area:
 - None
- d. Any affected customers, and other affected parties in the requested area.

- 2) Provide notice using the attached notice form(s).
- 3) Provide a copy of the map(s) deemed sufficient during administrative review delineating the requested area with each individual notice to neighboring utilities, other affected parties, landowners, and customers.
- 4) File in the docket a copy of notice and the map(s) deemed sufficient during administrative review along with the signed affidavit specifying every person and entity to whom notice was provided, and the date that the notice was provided.

Staff may determine that additional information is needed to make a final recommendation in this docket. If additional information is needed, Staff may send requests for information (RFI) to CSWR and Alpha Utility. CSWR and Alpha Utility will have 20 days from the receipt of these RFI's to respond.
