# COMMISSION STAFF'S PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On May 13, 2021, Undine Development, LLC (Undine) filed an application to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Travis County, Texas. Undine holds sewer CCN number 20948. The requested service area consists of 17 acres, zero existing connections, and zero proposed connections. Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission (Commission) of Texas filed its recommendation on sufficiency of notice on August 9, 2021.

On August 10, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 3, directing Staff to file a proposed procedural schedule by August 20, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

#### I. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Undine for review and consent	September 24, 2021
Deadline for Undine to file signed consent forms with the Commission	October 8, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	October 15, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to jointly file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	November 1, 2021
