**COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On May 13, 2021, Undine Development, LLC (Undine) filed an application to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Travis County, Texas. Undine holds sewer CCN No. 20948. The requested service area consists of 17 acres, zero existing connections, and zero proposed connections. Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission (Commission) of Texas filed its recommendation on final disposition on October 29, 2021.

On October 14, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 5, directing the parties to jointly file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law by November 15, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff and Undine are working together to prepare the required documents for filing. Staff respectfully requests that the parties' deadline to jointly file proposed findings and fact and conclusions of law be extended to November 29, 2021.

**II. CONCLUSION**

Staff respectfully requests an order extending the parties' deadline to file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law to November 29, 2021.
