**ORDER NO. 3**  
**FINDING AMENDED APPLICATION, AS SUPPLEMENTED,**  
**ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING NOTICE,**  
**ESTABLISHING SCHEDULE, AND RESTYLING DOCKET**

This Order addresses the May 17, 2021 application of Lumberton Municipal Utility District to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 10929 in Hardin County. On June 2, 2021, Lumberton MUD filed an amended application. On July 21, 2021, Lumberton MUD filed supplemental information to also request an amendment to its sewer CCN number 20367. On July 22, 2021, Lumberton MUD filed supplemental mapping information. On August 25, 2021, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed notice of the application.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the amended application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs Lumberton MUD to provide notice of the amended application and proof of notice in the manner described in and attached to Jolie Mathis' August 25, 2021 memorandum using the included forms.

The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for Lumberton MUD to file with the Commission signed affidavits that notice was given, along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	October 5, 2021
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice	October 15, 2021
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued

In light of Lumberton MUD's amended application, and supplements thereto, to include an amendment to its sewer CCN, this docket is restyled as reflected in this Order.
