I. BACKGROUND

On May 17, 2021, Applicant filed an application to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity in Hardin County. On November 16, 2021, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 5 establishing a procedural schedule.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION
