EL PASO ELECTRIC COMPANY'S RESPONSE TO COMMISSION STAFF'S NINTH REQUEST FOR INFORMATION QUESTION NOS. STAFF 9-1 THROUGH STAFF 9-5

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STAFF 9-1:

Please identify the types of commercial liability insurance plans that EPE possesses.

- a) Please provide the coverage term and coverage amounts for each insurance.
- b) Please provide the deductible and premium amounts for each insurance.

RESPONSE:

El Paso Electric Company possesses two Excess Liability Insurance policies or layers both with a coverage term of June 1, 2021 to June 1, 2022. The second layer does not apply until the first coverage layer is exhausted. The requested information for each layer is as follows:

- a) First layer has a limit of liability of \$35,000,000 per occurrence and \$70,000,000 general aggregate. Second layer has a limit of liability \$50,000,000 per occurrence subject to a \$50,000,000 annual aggregate for all occurrences.
- b) Please refer to EPE's response to STAFF 9-2, Attachments 1 and 2. The deductible amount is \$1,000,000 and the annual premium amount is \$1,943,567 for the first layer and the annual premium amount is \$526,225 for the second layer.

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
