EL PASO ELECTRIC COMPANY'S RESPONSE TO FREEPORT-MCMORAN, INC'S FOURTH REQUEST FOR INFORMATION QUESTION NOS. FMI 4-1 THROUGH FMI 4-4

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FMI 4-1:

Referring to the class cost-of-service study, please explain why EPE shows zero labor expenses for FERC account nos. 517 and 518 through 532.

RESPONSE:

Please refer to El Paso Electric Company's ("EPE") Schedule A-4, page 3 of 4, line 184, column (d) for \$189,579 of labor expenses related to EPE's employees, recorded to FERC account 524 – Miscellaneous Nuclear Power Expense. EPE records all costs related to the Palo Verde Generating Station ("PVGS") that are billed by Arizona Public Service Company ("APS"), the operating agent of PVGS, as operation and maintenance costs and does not break out labor costs. Therefore, only PVGS labor costs for EPE employees are recorded in FERC Account 524. All PVGS costs including PVGS labor are allocated using the 4CP A&E allocator. EPE's labor allocator would not include APS costs even if available as the labor allocator is used to allocate EPE costs not PVGS costs.
