#### **EPE 2-1:**

Will OPUC witness Mr. Evans' (sic) proposed base revenue increase distribution move all rate classes to cost? Please explain your answer.

#### **RESPONSE:**

No. Using Mr. Evans's proposed gradualism approach to the base revenue increase distribution was intended to move all rate classes toward EPE's fully allocated cost of service at a moderated level in order to avoid rate shock. Based on the wide range in the performance of rates for EPE's rate classes and the unusual conditions relative to the pandemic that prevailed during EPE's test-year, Mr. Evans does not believe it would be prudent to force all rate classes to their fully allocated cost of service in this rate case.
