Dear Ms. Christianson:

Thank you for the opportunity to present this proposal for cultural and natural resource surveys on Pueblo of Isleta lands in Bernalillo and Valencia counties, New Mexico. SWCA proposes to complete these surveys and submit reports suitable for supporting the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process for El Paso Electric Company's (EPEC) upcoming Right-of-Way (ROW) renewal. We understand that the right-of-way across Pueblo of Isleta lands is approximately 9 miles in length.

Task 1 - Cultural Resource survey

SWCA will perform a cultural resources survey of the EPEC ROW within Pueblo of Isleta lands. The ROW will be 100' wide and no more than 9 miles long. A 50' buffer will be surveyed on either side of the ROW to satisfy Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) requirements, for a total survey corridor width of 200'.

Deliverable will be a cultural resources report conforming to the requirements and guidelines of the BIA and the New Mexico Historic Preservation Division.

It is assumed that no more than two archaeological sites will be encountered and described in the report. The discovery of additional sites may increase cost.

Task 2 - General biological habitat and wetlands survey

SWCA will perform a biological and wetlands survey of the EPEC ROW within Pueblo of Isleta lands. The ROW will be 100 wide and no more than 9 miles long. It is assumed that no species-specific protocol surveys will be performed at this time.

Deliverable will be a biological memo detailing habitats present and possible impacts to special status species on Pueblo lands. The memo will also describe wetlands and Waters of the United

States (WOTUS) that will be crossed by the project. No formal wetland delineations will be performed, but potentially jurisdictional drainage crossings will be GPS-located and photographed.

Biological Resources Technical Memorandum

- 1. The report incorrectly states EPEC line is 115 kV, should be 345 kV.
- 2. With respect to wetlands and other waters the report ids 19 ephemeral drainages which all appear to intersect the existing transmission corridor. As I read the memo, SWCA is considering these non-jurisdictional. Could you lease add a clarifying comment one way or the other. This is significant for EPE because in the case of major maintenance and structure replacements, we may need to make surface improvements to allow the safe passage of large trailers, cranes, and other equipment. Would SWCA please add a comment regarding the permissibility of such improvements, with respect to the drainages and regulatory compliance requirements, if any.

Cultural Resources Inventory Report

- 1. The report incorrectly states EPEC line is 115 kV, should be 345 kV.
- 2. It appears EPE could meet most avoidance recommendations. However, two sites would be unavoidable during structure replacements and potentially maintenance activities.
 - i. LA 184016, EPE should be able to avoid. No structure replacement activities or two trace roads should impact site
 - ii. LA 184017, EPE would be unable to avoid during a structure replacement. Structure is 66ft south, EPE need 100x100' to replace structure will impact. Service road currently avoids as long as it does not move east.
 - iii. LA 184018, EPE should be able to avoid. No structure replacement activities or two trace roads should impact site
 - iv. LA 184019, EPE should be able to avoid. No structure replacement activities or two trace roads should impact site
 - v. LA 184020, EPE should be able to avoid. No structure replacement activities or two trace roads should impact site
 - vi. LA 184021, EPE would be unable to avoid impacts during maintenance or structure replacement. Current structure is located with site. Additionally EPE needs to move service road to the west outside of ROW to avoid impacts. Service road will be within Western ROW possibly
 - b. All of "should be able to avoid" judgments are based on information within report. Since I do not have GIS boundary layer of site I cannot determine location of structures in relation to the site other than what the reports states. Might be helpful to have the contractor put 100 ft. buffer around each structure to make sure that work area is not with 50ft of any site.
 - c. The section in the report talks about our transmission line as the historical property HCPI 40216. The description is a 115 kV line, which is incorrect. Also the description states that the actual age of structure is unknown, and a date rage of 1951 to 1971 was determined based on aerial photos. EPE can confirm that the entire line was constructed in 1968 and 1967
 - i. We'd like to discuss the ramifications of calling our lines historic. Even though this report does not recommend them as eligible, this is of interest to EPE because much of our grid is greater than 50 years old

EPE is concerned about overpromising with respect to avoidance – would like to discuss couching the language. Because the line is existing (and old), structure maintenance and replacement will be necessary at some point and the proximity of sites to existing structures makes avoidance and near impossibility. A detailed discussion is probably premature in this report and would likely be addressed in a treatment plan but we'd like to discuss this with SWCA.

WEST MESA - ARROYO 345kV RIGHT OF WAY RENEWAL RESOURCE MAP BOOK









I have attached a draft of the presentation for review. I attempted to answer a few of their questions in a round a bout way. With the WECC references I was trying to highlight the fact that this line has regional benefit (for EPE and PNM (ergo the Pueblo as well)). I also made reference to the facts that this is one of a few WECC paths we have and that our system is designed to handle a single contingency situations as well. Trying to highlight the fact it is valuable to them indirectly, but not our only line tie.. I am not sure if Slide 6 should stay, or if we should add something more. I was trying to communicate that the line will still be needed once we get rid of our Four Corners interest, but that may be implied in the earlier slides.

I didn't make any mention of our desired term of renewal, the 25 CFR renewal, the existing line specifics, when we received grant, etc.. as we have already spoken about that. However, if you all feel there is value in that, or that the PowerPoint is too short, I am happy to add it back in.

The "Next Steps" slide is empty. I assume we will lob that out as a bit of a question, but if we would like, I can put items in there regarding getting surveys done, cost negotiation, etc..

I didn't make mention of the ongoing maintenance activities on that line, as it doesn't have much to do with this renewal, but I wouldn't be surprised if we get a question or two.

Lastly, after this meeting if we discuss timing and getting this completed before November is not feasible or will be very challenging, perhaps we can consider negotiating and agreeing to the price portion of this with actual payment to come when complete. That could be a positive for Council members
