ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the June 1, 2021 application of Aqua Texas, Inc. to amend sewer certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 21116 in Williamson County. On July 1, 2021 Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed a procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application as described in the July 1, 2021 memorandum of Jolie Mathis attached to Commission Staff's recommendation, using the included forms attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for Aqua Texas to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	August 16, 2021 ¹
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and propose a procedural schedule	August 25, 2021
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued

Because the deadline for Aqua Texas to file signed affidavits with the Commission falls on a Sunday, August 15, 2021, it is extended to the next business day under 16 TAC § 22.4(a).
