ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, PROPOSED NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the June 3, 2021 application of Sun Water Supply Corporation to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity in Taylor, Jones, and Fisher counties. On July 6, 2021 Commission Staff filed its clarification to Order No. 2, and supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness, proposed notice and proposed procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicant to provide notice of the application as described in the July 9, 2021 memorandum of Patricia Garcia, and attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for SUN water to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	August 23, 2021
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of the notice	September 3, 2021
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
