**ORDER NO. 7**  
**GRANTING REQUEST TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff’s January 7, 2022 request to amend the procedural schedule. Commission Staff has identified an issue with the mapping data and requested area at issue in this docket due to the effect of the streamlined expedited release in Docket No. 52474, in which 205.3 acres of land is being released from Polonia WSC’s certificated area.<sup>1</sup> Commission Staff requests the amendment of the procedural schedule to allow Commission Staff and applicants to work together to amend the maps in this docket to be consistent with Order No. 4 in Docket No. 52474. Commission Staff indicates that Aqua Water Supply Corporation does not oppose this request.

The administrative law judge grants the request and amends the procedural schedule as follows:

Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a supplemental recommendation on the approval of the sale and on the CCN amendment	February 7, 2022
Deadline for parties to file a supplemental response to Commission Staff’s recommendation on approval of sale	February 9, 2022
Deadline for parties to file a supplemental joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving the sale and allowing transaction to proceed	February 14, 2022
