ORDER NO. 8 FINDING NOTICE DEFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice provided by Evan Staton for the transfer of an exempt utility, Lone Oak Water System (exempt registration number N0059). On February 17, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on notice.

In Order No. 7 filed on January 10, 2022 the administrative law judge required the applicants to proceed with providing public notice to all current customers and to each future customer at the time they connect to the system. To date, the applicants have not filed proof that notice was provided to all existing customers.

Accordingly, the ALJ finds the notice deficient and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in and attached to Commission Staff's January 7, 2022 recommendation. The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule:
