COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON NOTICE

On June 30, 2021, Garth Duncan, Rhonda Hardin, and Evan Staton (collectively, Applicants) filed what appears to be an application for the sale, transfer, or merger (STM) of an exempt utility and associated registration number N0059. The Applicants filed supplemental information on October 14, 2021 and December 8, 2021.

On March 4, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 8, requiring the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), to a recommendation on sufficiency of notice by April 18, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. NOTICE

On January 7, 2022, Staff recommended that the Applicants proceed with providing public notice to all current customers and to each future customer at the time they connect to the system. On March 4, 2022, the Applicants provided copies of the notice forms sent to all existing customers. Staff has reviewed the provided notice forms and recommends that notice be deemed sufficient.

II. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE
