FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice of the application for the transfer of an exempt utility, Lone Oak Water System (exempt registration number N0059).


On March 4, 2022, the applicants provided copies of the notice forms sent to all current customers. On April 18, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the provided notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice provided sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide proposed final map, tariff, and consent forms to the applicants	May 6, 2022
Deadline for the applicants to file signed consent forms with the Commission	May 20, 2022
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on final disposition, or to request a hearing	June 3, 2022
Deadline for the applicants to respond to Commission Staff's recommendation or request a hearing	June 17, 2022
If no disputed issues, deadline for the parties to file a joint proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering provisions, and a request to admit relevant evidence	July 1, 2022
