ORDER NO. 9 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice of the application for the transfer of an exempt utility, Lone Oak Water System (exempt registration number N0059).
