### COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On June 30, 2021, Meritage Homes of Texas, LLC (Meritage) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from the City of Melissa's (Melissa) water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 11482 under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h).<sup>1</sup> Meritage asserts that the land to be released is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Collin, which is a qualifying county.

On September 13, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 5, establishing a deadline of September 22, 2021 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the notice and to propose a procedural schedule for the further processing of this docket. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

### I. SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

Under 16 TAC § 24.245(h)(3)(f), a landowner seeking streamlined expedited release must provide proof that a copy of the petition has been mailed to the current CCN holder via certified mail on the day that the landowner submits the petition to the Commission. Meritage stated that it mailed a copy of its petition to the CCN holder, Melissa, by certified mail on the day the petition was filed with the Commission but did not include an affidavit attesting to this provision of notice.

This proceeding, Docket No. 52293, will address the petition of Meritage Homes for streamlined expedited release from water CCN number 11482 held by City of Melissa in Collin County.

On September 8, 2021, Meritage subsequently filed an affidavit attesting that a copy of the revised notice was sent by certified mail to Melissa. Accordingly, Staff recommends that the notice is sufficient.
