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**ORDER NO. 3
GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION IN PART**

On June 30, 2021, Meritage Homes of Texas, LLC filed a petition to amend North Collin Special Utility District's and City of Melissa's water certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Collin County by streamlined expedited release. In Order No. 2, filed on July 27, 2021, the administrative law judge granted petitioner's request for an extension allowing petitioner to file a motion to sever by August 13, 2021.

On August 4, 2021, North Collins filed a request for 30-day extension of time to review and respond to the separate petition related to North Collin's CCN to be filed by petitioner. Alternatively, if petitioner's separate petition will be addressed in a separate proceeding, then North Collin requests that the deadline of August 6, 2021, for CCN holders to respond in this proceeding is no longer applicable to North Collin. Further, North Collin has conferred with petitioner and Commission Staff, and the parties are unopposed to this request.

The administrative law judge grants North Collins's request for extension in part. By September 7, 2021, North Collin may respond to the separate petition related to North Collin's CCN to be filed by petitioner, or in the alternative, respond to the petition in the current docket. Additionally, by September 7, 2021, the City of Melissa may respond to the petition in the current docket.
