RE: Senate Bill 3, 87th Legislature, Regular Session Compliance Guidance –  
Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.1396

Dear Public Utility Commission of Texas:

The Trinity River Authority of Texas (Authority) is an affected utility as identified in Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.1396. Senate Bill 3, 87th Legislature, Regular Session requires an affected utility provider to provide written notice to key organization identifying the critical infrastructure requiring Critical Load status.

TWC § 13.1394 defines an “affected utility” as a retail public utility, exempt utility, or provider or conveyor of potable or raw water service that:

- Furnishes water service to more than one customer;
- In a county with a population of 3.3 million or more;
- In a county with a population of 550,000 or
- more adjacent to a county with a population of 3.3 million or more.

Below you will find the TRA utility that meets these criteria and has been deemed as critical infrastructure.

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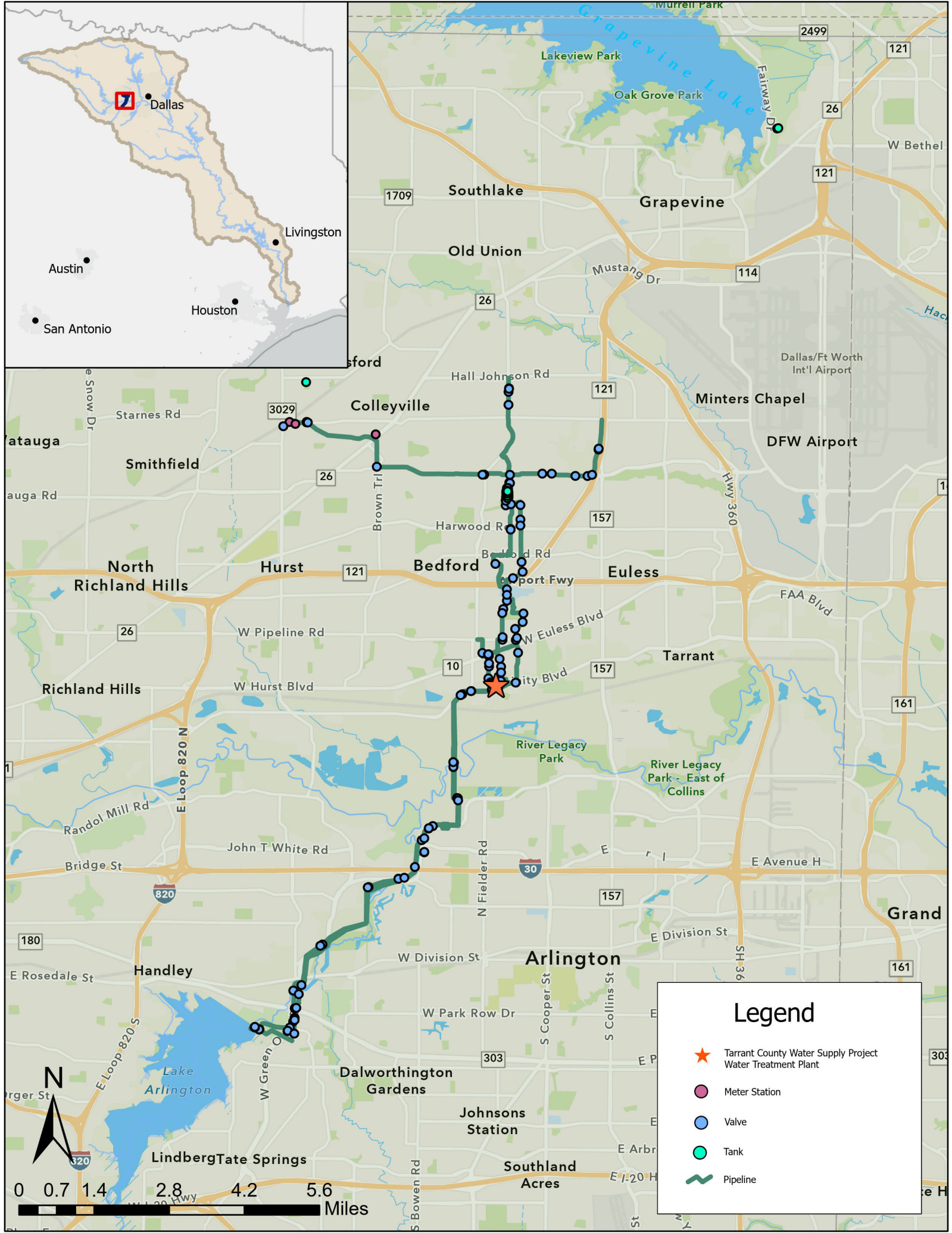

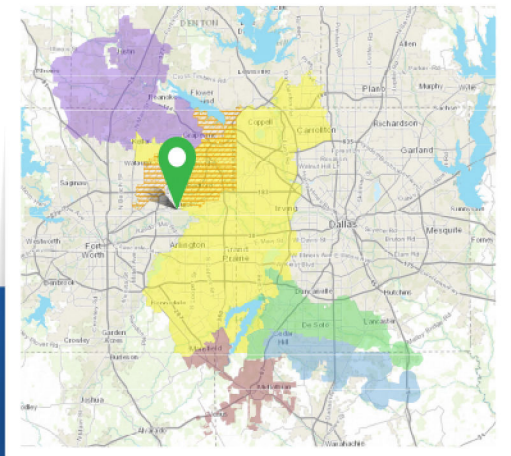
## TARRANT COUNTY WATER SUPPLY PROJECT

The Tarrant County Water Supply Project provides regional treated water service to five contracting parties with a population numbering approximately 245,000. The facility is located on Trinity Boulevard at the boundary between the city of Fort Worth and the city of Euless. The project consists of an 87 MGD water treatment plant, pipelines, and pump stations necessary to transport the raw water from Lake Arlington to the treatment plant, and distribution pipelines and pump stations necessary to pump the treated water to the Murphy Drive Pump Station and storage site and then to the contracting parties' distribution systems.
