In accordance with Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT) Project 52299 (affected utilities):

The City of University Park (municipality) provides potable water and wastewater services to approximately 10,228 residential and commercial connections.

- **Facilities are located as noted below**

The City of University Park purchases treated water from the Dallas County Park Cities Municipal Utility District (DCPCMUD). The City utilizes a booster pump station and two elevated water storage tanks to manage water storage and pressure within the distribution system. Details for these facilities is below.

1. Germany Park Booster Pump Station located at 4519 Drane Drive has four (4) VFD pumps that are monitored and maintained by the DCPCMUD. The booster pump station pumps into the transmission system to the elevated storage tanks as well as directly into the distribution system.
2. The Fondren Elevated Storage Tank is located at 2601 Fondren and is a 2-million gallon water storage tank. The water levels of the tank are monitored and maintained by the DCPCMUD.
3. The Northwest Highway Elevated Storage Tank is located at 3531 Northwest Parkway and is a 2-million gallon water storage tank. The water levels of the tank are monitored and maintained by the DCPCMUD.

The City of University Park contracts with Dallas Water Utilities of the City of Dallas Texas for collection and treatment of the city's wastewater. The City of University Park maintains the collection system and has no other sewer facilities.
