In accordance with Texas Water Code (TWC) §13.1396 established under Senate Bill 3 of the 87th Legislature of the State of Texas, City of Taylor TX Utility Department is sending the following information in case of an emergency in which one or multiple of our facilities lose power. We request that this letter, and all information contained within it, be filed confidentially due to the sensitive information contained within it.

Water Facilities

The City of Taylor TX purchases potable water from the Brazos River Authority, operates a distribution system, and sends potable water to the Cities of Hutto and Thrall. As part of this system, the following facilities are considered critical load facilities:

- Utility Maintenance Office
- Ford Tank Pump Station
- North Pump Station
- Mallard Water Tower
- West Water Tower
- Murphy Water Tower
- Southwood Hills Elevated Tank

The addresses and electric meter numbers for these facilities are included in Table 1 at the end of this letter.

Sewer Facilities

The POTW includes a collection system and the Mustang Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant (Mustang Creek WWTP), which has a current design capacity of 4.0-MGD. As part of this system, the following facilities are considered critical load facilities:

- Mustang Creek WWTP
- South Wood Lift Station
- Airport Lift Station
- HEB Lift Station

The addresses and electric meter numbers for these facilities are included in Table 2 at the end of this letter.


