Location and general description of all critical load water and wastewater facilities:



Dear Customers,

As a result of the ongoing rulemaking at the Public Utility Commission and the Railroad Commission of Texas, LCRA TSC is transitioning its method for critical load review. The EEA Load Shed List, which was previously provided monthly, will no longer be circulated via e-mail. Instead, we are working to develop a solution such that each entity's critical load information will be stored separately for representatives to review. In the interim, please provide any updates to your critical load list via e-mail reply to me. At the conclusion of the rulemakings, LCRA will follow up with an update to this process.

In addition to our normal monthly outreach and communication on this topic, I would like to communicate an additional request:

• Should you be in receipt of an Application for Critical Load Serving Electric Generation and Cogeneration form (example attached) related to critical natural gas loads that you serve via your distribution system, please provide those forms via reply e-mail. Also, for each critical load, please provide the substation, transformer, and feeder designation. This will allow us to have better visibility and situational awareness should this information be pertinent to system operations.

And finally, as always, attached are the following:

1. EEA Master List 12.29.2021

This is a way of showing you the information in our "Communicator System." Instead of three lists there is only one list—with "checks-far to the right of the screen" of the notices you receive. If you see two entries for a name, that is to allow for separate notices for e-mail and/or text messages. Focus on the "checks", e-mail address and text address for a given name for accuracy. Please review and let us know if any updates need to be made.

2. January 2022 EEA Load Shed Email List (The list used to produce this email)

Please let me know if any updates are needed to the distribution list.
