In accordance with Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT) Project 52299 (affected utilities)

The City of Hico (municipality) provides water and wastewater services to approximately 678 residential and commercial connections.

Facilities are located as noted below:

- 1. Raw/potable water well and ground storage: City of Hico facility located at 204 Utility St. (1) 0.2 MG ground storage tank, (1) primary SCADA control system which provides corresponding data to operate wells and booster pumps, (1) water well-Well #6, (1) chlorination system and (2) booster pumps which provide fill to the elevated storage tank and operate on a 24/7 basis.
- 2. <u>Raw/potable water well:</u> Well #5 located at the southeast corner of S. Mesquite St. and Utility St. which supplements water to the ground storage tank and operates on a 24/7 basis.
- 3. <u>Potable water:</u> Iredell elevated storage located at 511 Iredell Rd. has (1) 0.15 MG elevated storage tank which provides gravity pressure to the entire distribution system and operates on a 24/7 basis.
- 4. Sewer wastewater treatment plant: The City of Hico WWTP located at 405 Utility St. is comprised of (1) ICEAS wastewater treatment facility, (1) aluminum sulfate distribution system, (1) chlorination system and (1) belt filter press that operate on a 24/7 basis.
- 5. <u>Sewer lift station:</u> Greasewood Prop. Subdivision lift station located at 1004 Old Stephenville Rd. has (2) pumps which move raw sewage from the surrounding area to the gravity feed city collection system and operate on a 24/7 basis.
- 6. <u>Sewer lift station</u>: Hico City Park lift station located at 501 S. Elm St.-RV Park has (2) pumps which move raw sewage from the surrounding area to the gravity feed city collection system and operate on a 24/7 basis.
- 7. Sewer lift station: Hwy 281 N lift station located at N. Hwy 281-LIFT has (2) pumps which move raw sewage from the surrounding area to the gravity feed city collection and operate on a 24/7 basis.
- 8. <u>Sewer lift station:</u> Pine St. lift station located at 207 Pine St. has (2) pumps which move raw sewage from the surrounding area to the gravity feed city collection and operate on a 24/7 basis.
- 9. <u>Sewer lift station:</u> Utility St. lift station located at 405 Utility St. has (3) pumps which move raw sewage into the WWTP and operate on a 24/7 basis.
