To Whom It May Concern,

This letter serves as notice that Oak Manor MUD (the District) owns and operates a water plant (WP) and a wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) which are critical the health and safety of the District.

The WP is located at 603 County Road 193 (AKA Mohawk Ln), Alvin, TX, 77511 and consists of an on-site well, ground storage tank, booster pumps, and a hydropneumatic tank supplying potable water to the roughly 163 connections in the District. The plant also receives source water from two off-site wells.

The WWTP is located at 7926 S Highway 35, Alvin, TX 77511 and consists of a bullseye treatment plant and outfall to Chocolate Bayou receiving flow from roughly 163 connections. The plant receives flow from an off-site lift station for a portion of those connections.

Note: Retail Customers designated as a Critical Load Industrial Customer are not guaranteed uninterrupted electric power supply. If electricity is a necessity, it is the responsibility of the Retail Customer to make arrangements for alternate sources of electric power.
