Dear PUC Emergency Management,

This letter is written in response to the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) Project 5229, Senate Bill 3, 87<sup>th</sup> Legislature, Regular Session Compliance Guidance, Texas Water Code (TWC) §13.1396.

Canyon Regional Water Authority (CRWA) is a wholesale water district located near New Braunfels Texas and operates three drinking water treatment facilities that serve various municipalities, water districts and utilities across six counties.

The first of CRWA's treatment facilities is the Lake Dunlap Water Treatment Plant (WTP) located at 850 Lakeside Pass, New Braunfels Texas 78130. Lake Dunlap WTP is a surface water treatment plant that serves a population of 100,000 or greater in the Northeast rural portions of San Antonio. The transmission pipeline travels from Lake Dunlap WTP to the Northeast section of San Antonio and is supported by two booster stations. The Wagner Booster Station and the Loop 1604 Booster Station are also critical infrastructure and should be included in the critical load status with the Lake Dunlap WTP. The Wagner Booster Station is located at 1084 E. FM 78, Cibolo Texas, 78108; the Loop 1604 Booster Station is located at 5207 East Loop 1604, San Antonio Texas, 78124.

The second facility CRWA owns and operates is the Wells Ranch WTP located at 383 Highpoint Ridge, Seguin Texas, 78155. Wells Ranch WTP is a groundwater treatment plant that serves a population of 100,000 or greater in the Northeast rural portions of San Antonio. The transmission pipeline travels from the Wells Ranch WTP to the Northeast side of San Antonio. Additionally, the Wells Ranch Pipeline contains the Leissner Booster station located at 2797 Leissner School Rd, Seguin Texas, 78155. The Leissner Booster Station and the Wells Ranch WTP are critical load facilities.

The third facility CRWA owns and operates is the Hays Caldwell WTP located at 135 Martindale Rd, San Marcos Texas, 78666. Hays Caldwell WTP is a surface water treatment facility that serves a population of 30,000 people. The pipeline leaving Hays Caldwell WTP is either managed or owned by others.
