RE: Request for Critical Load designation for Travis County WCID 10 Project 52299

Travis County Water Control and Improvement District No. 10 (the "District"), also known as WCID #10, is a political subdivision of the State of Texas, and was created by a petition filed with Travis County, Texas, on August 10, 1956 and a confirmation election was held on September 29, 1956.

The District is located in western Travis County, and it includes portions of the City of West Lake Hills and the major subdivisions of Westwood, Rolling Hills West, Knollwood, Westlake Highlands, Sundown Parkway, Camelot, and the original Rob Roy Ranch. Overall, the District covers an area of approximately 5,000 acres, and has about 3,000 residential, business, and emergency service/hospital customers. The population of the service area is over 10,000 people. The District is also a wholesale water provider for Lower Camelot Water Supply Corporation.

The Water District was established pursuant to Article XVI, Section 59 of the State of Texas Constitution, and Chapters 49 and 51 of the Texas Water Code, as amended. TheDistrict is subject to the continuing supervision of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. The Water District was created for the purposes of providing, operating, and maintainingfacilities to distribute potable water along with water for fire protection.

A water delivery system operating with uninterrupted electrical service is absolutely necessary to allow the District to serve the 5,000-acre service area of western Travis County -- to provide both drinking water, water for our hospital, and water for fire protection. Travis County Emergency Services District No. 9 must have water available to suppress house fires - and to prevent house fires from becoming wildfires. Customers of the Water District face higher than normal wildfire risks due to our dense urban forest of flammable cedar trees, hilly terrain, and the lingering effects posed by recent and recurring drought conditions.

Should the District be unable to run our pumps, we would be unable to provide water for the residents, the area hospital, schools and emergency services, or for fire protection. Therefore, the District respectfully requests designation as Critical Load as it serves as a public health and safety provider.

I confirm that Travis County WCID 10 is an "affected utility" per TWC 13.
