The water system is comprised of 1 water treatment plant to treat raw water from the Canadian River Municipal Water Authority (CRMWA), 15 municipal wells, 4 elevated storage tanks, and 5 pump stations with ground storage.

Water for municipal use provided from the CRMWA is gravity flow from the aqueduct into the Surface Water Treatment Plant (SWTP) located at 3600 W 16<sup>th</sup> street for treatment and distribution. The municipal wells are pumped and treated at the well sites and are put directly in the distribution system. The SWTP is the control center for all operations of the water system. This includes the remote operation of the treatment process, wells, booster stations, and monitoring pressure in the system.

The city provides water to approximately 20,742 residents thru 7,663 connections, along with an emergency interconnect for the Seth Ward Water system.

The Wastewater system consists of 1 treatment plant and 8 lift stations. The sewer collection system relies on gravity flow and pressure sewers to move the wastewater from homes and businesses to the POTW. In the event of power loss, the sewer system will begin to back up and overflow causing a public health concern, along with illicit discharges. The water reclamation plant located at 1059 County Road Y is the control center for the treatment of wastewater and remote operation of the lift stations.

The city provides sewer service to approximately 20,742 residents thru 7,180 connections.
