In accordance with Senate Bill 3, Milligan WSC is defined as an “affected utility”. This letter is to satisfy the requirement of identifying the water system, as well as provide contact information.

The official name of the system is Milligan Water Supply Corporation.

Milligan WSC is a distribution system purchasing 100% of our water supply from the North Texas Municipal Water District. At this time Milligan WSC has only one pump station, located at 210 S. Bridgefarmer Road, Mckinney Texas. This is the only location that would require critical load status. On October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021, Milligan WSC received approval from our electric provider for the pump station to be considered a critical load connection. I am attaching a copy of this approval, as well as the application for the approval with this letter.


