To the Public Utility Commission:

The City of Sugar Land (the "City") is a home rule city with water and wastewater facilities that need to be identified for critical load status.

The City submits the following information to the Public Utility Commission of Texas pursuant to Texas Water Code § 13.1396 as the owner of certain water/wastewater facilities within Ft. Bend County. Additionally, this information will also be submitted to each transmission and distribution service provider, retail electric provider, and the Ft. Bend County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management where the City has water or sewer facilities that qualify for critical load status.

The City has identified facilities as qualifying for critical load status. Information providing the general description and location of these critical load facilities are included as Exhibit A.
