General: In accordance with TWC 13.1394 all entities that meet the definition of “Affected Utilities” must file specific information with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT) in Project 52299. In addition, the information must also be filed with each transmission and distribution service provider, each retail electric provider, and the office of emergency management of each county where the utility has water or sewer facilities that qualify for critical load status.

The City of Nocona water & sewer infrastructure facilities does meet the definition of “Affected Utilities” therefore, the following information is being provided and will be filed with the PUCT and other entities as required.

Existing Critical Load Facilities: City of Nocona maintains and operates multiple infrastructure utilities that are critical load facilities, including the 1) Raw Water Intake & Pump Station at Lake Nocona, 2) Water Treatment Plant, 3) West Wastewater Treatment Plant and 4) South Wastewater Treatment Plant. These Critical Load Facilities are described in more detail as follows:

1) Raw Water Intake & Pump Station at Lake Nocona:

Physical Location: 200 Storey Road, Nocona, Texas (Shore of Lake Nocona)

Description: This critical load facility takes raw water from Lake Nocona and pumps it to the City of Nocona Water Treatment Plant where it is treated to produce potable water and is the only source of drinking water to the entire City of Nocona, with a population of approximately

3,100 people. Uninterrupted and continuous operation of this facility is critical to the public health & safety of the City of Nocona residents including portions of Montague County.

2) **Potable Water Treatment Plant:**

Physical Location: 401 E. Bois D'Arc, Nocona, Texas

Description: This critical load facility receives raw water from Lake Nocona and provides all required treatment and disinfection of the raw water in strict compliance with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to produce safe potable drinking water to the entire City of Nocona, with a population of approximately 3,100 people. Uninterrupted and continuous operation of this facility is critical to the public health & safety of the City of Nocona residents including portions of Montague County.

3) **West Wastewater Treatment Plant:**

Physical Location: 610 West Locust St., Nocona, Texas

Description: This critical load facility receives wastewater, including residential and commercial sanitary sewer flows from the western & northwestern portions of the City of Nocona (Estimated Service Population of 1,240 people) and provides for all treatment to maintain safe and sanitary conditions prior to discharge of the treated waste into designated TCEQ approved stream segments. Uninterrupted and continuous operation of this facility is critical to the public health & safety of the City of Nocona residents including portions of Montague County.

4) **South Wastewater Treatment Plant:**

Physical Location: 735 Montague St. Nocona, Texas

Description: This critical load facility receives wastewater, including residential and commercial sanitary sewer flows from the eastern & southeastern portions of the City of Nocona (Estimated Service Population of 1,860 people) and provides for all treatment to maintain safe and sanitary conditions prior to discharge of the treated waste into designated TCEQ approved stream segments. Uninterrupted and continuous operation of this facility is critical to the public health & safety of the City of Nocona residents including portions of Montague County.
